

Christopher G. Padgett, PCC, CPCC, is a leadership and executive team coach and facilitator. A Louisville, Kentucky native, he is an 8th generation Kentuckian and was one of the very first coaches to earn the Professional Certified Coach credential in Kentucky from the International Coach Federation. During his two terms as president (2015-2016) of ICF Ohio Valley, membership doubled and the number of credential earners tripled, culminating in the chapter earning a global chapter award for excellence in operations in 2016. As chapter president, Chris was a vocal advocate for modernizing operations and bringing radical transparency to chapter and global operations. He also led the expansion of the Ohio Valley chapter into West Virginia and created Ohio Valley's chapter awards program which each year recognizes a Coach of the Year, Leadership Award, and Hall of Fame Award. Chris served as global co-leader of the ICF Team and Group Coaching of Community of Practice and helped organize monthly educational programming for over 500 coaches on six continents.
