- Volunteer leadership: Participation in chapter events and meetings
- Integration with chapter leadership team: Ability to collaborate and co-create with other leadership team members and chapter virtual assistant
- Fiduciary and ethical accountability: Follow chapter policies and procedures

- ICF credential holder (ACC, PCC, or MCC) or current enrollment working towards completion of an ICF Accredited Coach Training Program (ACTP) with the intent of obtaining an ICF credential
